Entry limits: 50 total runs per day maximum, 12 duck runs and 20 cattle runs per day maximum (sheep -5 head per run-B course, 3-A course; cattle - 3 head per run; ducks - 5 head per run).

Please bring your own chairs, dog supplies, etc. Dress for Illinois spring weather. We could have 40 degrees or 90+ degrees.

Food will be available at the site. Schedule with a map will be provided. Bitches in season will be allowed, but must move to the end of the test class. Please notify the secretary if your bitch is in season.

THE AMERICAN KENNEL CLUB RULES REGARDING CONDUCT WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.

No refund for duplicate entries or any other cause beyond the control of the club after closing dates.

RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY. NO CONDITIONAL ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED. ENTRY FORMS MUST BE SIGNED.

A separate form for each class must be completed for each dog entered. Entries not on official AKC entry forms and photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules

on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Forms are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

Owners or their agents are solely responsible for the presence of their dog(s) at the test/trial arena. Judges are not responsible to wait for dogs.

Exhibitors are expected to maintain the premises in a clean and tidy condition.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by action Test/Trial committee.

I (we) acknowledge that the "Rules Applying to registration and Dog Shows" and the "rules for Herding Tests & Trials" have been made available to me (us), and that I (we) agree that the club holding this Herding Test or Trial has the right to refuse this entry for cause, which the club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and the holding of the Herding Test or Trial and of the opportunity to have the dog tested or judged and to win prize money, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the club, its members, directors, governors and employees of the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of the dog while in or upon the Herding Test or Trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other causes.

I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves) or on account of damages to property arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this Herding Test or Trial however such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.
