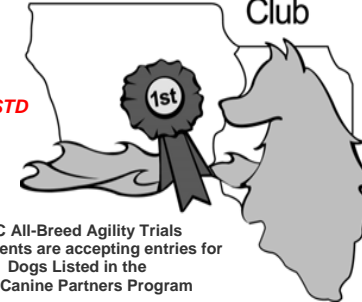

Wait List for Withdrawn Entries after the Closing January 13, 2012 12:00 p.m.

SCKC is offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing on Jan. 13, 2012 at 12:00 p.m. A maximum of 25 entries per day will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to Jan. 13, 2012 at 12:00 p.m. Any entries withdrawn that are received by Jan. 23, 2012 6 p.m. will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by Jan. 23, 2012 6:00 p.m. will receive a full refund. If a dog is pulled after Jan. 13th but cannot be replaced, the exhibitor will not receive a refund and the dog will be considered absent for the trials.

Regulations for Agility Trials.

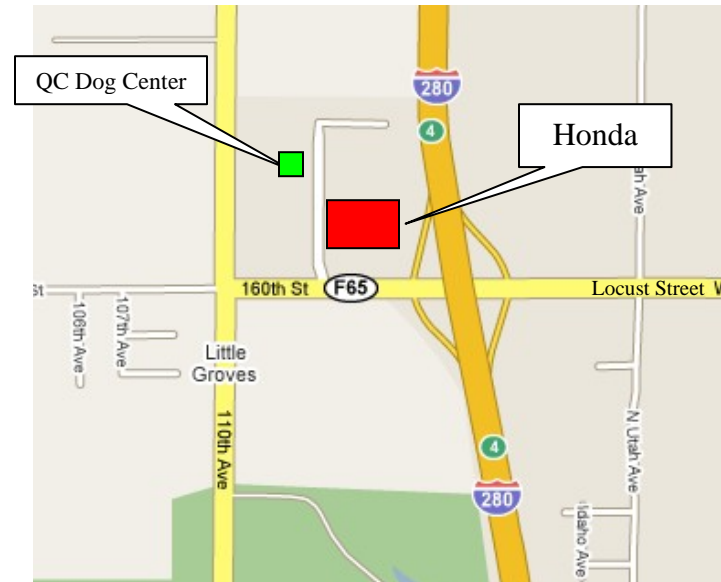
NO phone or FAX entries will be accepted or scanned.

All handlers must pick up after their dogs at trial site and all hotel sites. Anyone not cleaning up after their dogs will be requested to leave. No refunds will be given.

Directions to Quad City Dog Center

Quad City Dog Center is conveniently located off I-280 in Davenport, Iowa. in the West Lake Industrial Park.

From the North or Northeast, take US 61 or I-88 to I-80 West. Follow I-80 West to I-280 East. Exit at Iowa Exit 4, West Locust Street. Turn right on West Locust and proceed one block to West Lake Boulevard. Turn right. Quad City Dog Center is at 2390 West Lake Boulevard, across from Honda plant.

From the East, take I-80 to I-74 to I-280 West. Follow I-280, crossing the Mississippi River. Exit at Iowa Exit 4, West Locust Street. Turn left on West Locust and proceed one block to West Lake Boulevard. Turn right. Quad City Dog Center is at 2390 West Lake Boulevard, across from Honda plant.

From the South, take I-74 West to I-280 West. Follow I-280 west, crossing the Mississippi River. Exit at Iowa Exit 4, West Locust Street. Turn left on West Locust and proceed one block to West Lake Boulevard. Turn right. Quad City Dog Center is at 2390 West Lake Boulevard, across from Honda plant.

From the West, take I-80 east to I-280, follow to Exit 4, West Locust Street. Turn right on West Locust, proceed one block to West Lake Boulevard. Turn right. Quad City Dog Center is at 2590 West Lake Boulevard, across from Honda plant.

AGILITY TRIAL – MOVE-UP FORM SCOTT COUNTY KENNEL CLUB

This form MUST be filled out completely and sent to the Event Secretary (Roger Thayer P.O. Box 2069 Davenport, Ia. 52809) or the information may be sent to the Trial Secretary via email (sckc.ag@mchsi.com). If you use email, all information requested below must be included in the note. **NO** verbal changes will be accepted. Fill out one form for each dog and give/mail to Trial Secretary. Move-ups will be added to the end of the running order of the class they move-up to, however, every effort will be made to accommodate handlers running multiple dogs in the same class.

AKC regulations require **the deadline for the Friday trial will be Monday, Jan. 23, 2012 6:00 p.m. Deadline for the Saturday trial will be the close of the last class on Friday, Jan. 27, 2012. Deadline for the Sunday trial will be the close of the last class on Saturday, Jan. 28, 2012.** A dog which has been entered in a Novice "A" class for which it is not eligible to be entered in due to class restrictions on the dog or handler may be moved to the Novice "B" class under the following conditions: The request for the move must be in writing and presented to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. The request must state the reason and justification for the move from Novice "A" class to the Novice "B" class."

*In Regular classes dogs may run in a higher division than their proper division, but those that run in a height division lower than their proper division will be eliminated.

**Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. Dogs MUST jump in their measured division in the Preferred classes.

***When entering a Preferred or Regular class the dog must not crossover between them at the same set of trials.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER -These trials are open to all pure bred dogs 15 months of age or older that are registered with the AKC or are register-able breeds that have obtained AKC PAL/ILP and AKC-Canine Partners listing numbers, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Refer to Ch. 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of breeds that may participate.

CONFIRMATION OF ENTRY - Email confirmation of entries will be sent when entered. PLEASE, open and read so any corrections can be made at that time!! Please make sure your **email address is legible and valid**. Self-addressed and stamped postcards or envelopes included with your entry will also be mailed back.

Corrections must be made before the close of the trial!

AWARDS – Rosettes are awarded for 1st thru 4th place in each jump height of each class and division. Qualifying ribbons awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. MACH, PACH, & PAX bar with rosette, MX/MXJ cone, and new title rosettes in all classes will be provided. A small plush toy, laser light, waste bag holder, bowl or a tooth brush for all dogs - one per weekend depending on availability. *No unclaimed awards or ribbons will be mailed.*

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS - Safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from the competition by action of the Trial Committee. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and or children engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior or create unnecessary disturbances, may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such a case, no refund of any fee paid will be made.

REFUNDS No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by means of riot, civil disturbance, fire, act of God, emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Entry fees will be refunded in full if a written request (mail or email) is received by the trial secretary on or before the trial closing date. A full refund will be reimbursed to any entrant whose entry is replaced by a Wait Listed entry. The club will refund the entry fee minus \$2 per run for bitches unable to compete because they are in season if a written request and a certificate or letter from a veterinarian is received by the trial secretary prior to the start of judging. The club will issue a full refund of entries in the case of death or critical illness of either dog or handler.

**All dogs must be on a leash at all times on the show grounds except in the ring and at the designated warm-up jump area.
Only dogs 6 months and older in age are allowed on the show grounds.**
